- Support our local non-profit, Island Trails Network (ITN), to build and maintain sustainable trails for all to enjoy.

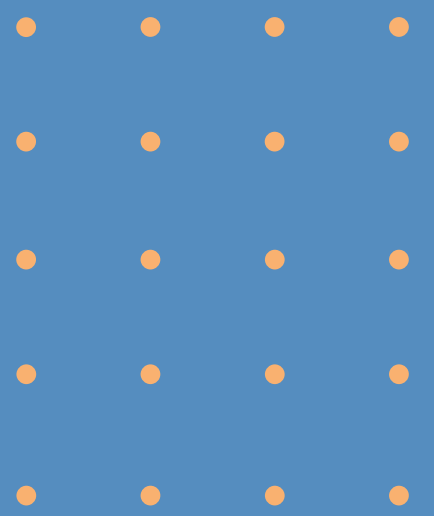

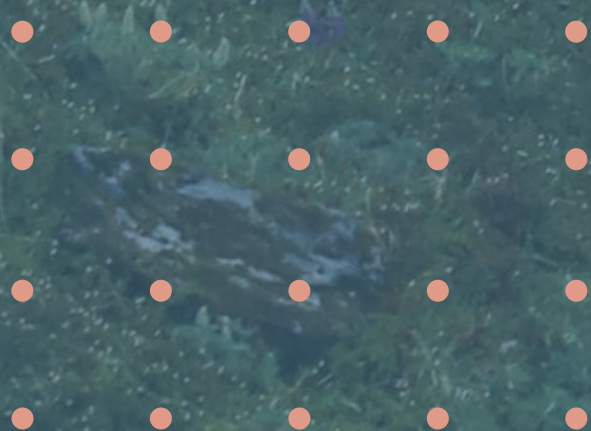

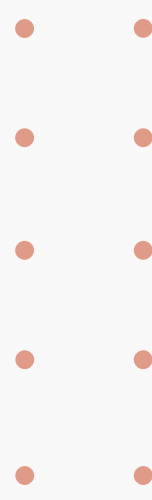

Cut off - 4 Hours, volunteers and crew will be absent by 10pm.

+ Sharatin

Start - 4pm, Friday June 19th.
Cut off - 5 Hours, volunteers and crew will be absent by 9pm.

+ Pyramid

Start - 2pm, Saturday June 20th.
Cut off - 4 Hours, volunteers and crew will be absent by 6pm.


Heitman

This is a one-way course offering a quick up with a little ridge fun once at the top. On the way down, you'll pass Heitman Lake, a Kodiak classic for catching a trout or two. We can't promise trout at the finish, but perhaps a Twizzler or two.

SHARATIN

This course begins on single track, starting up Red Cloud. This will quickly put you into the alpine, where shale and rock become the M.O. The rounded summit offers up quick running across shale. After summiting, you'll move down into Shelly Lake, an absolute picnic of a spot. A quick climb out, and then it's a hot trot down to the finish.

PYRAMID

This course begins on single track up Pyramid mountain. You can expect clear flagging where single track may split off in order to keep you on track. Once you summit you will head down the ridge eventually splitting off to the right. The trail here can often be missed, flagging will keep you on track until you get back to single track. Once you hit the road you'll take a right and bring it home.

Bag Drop

Drop Bags will be available days 1 & 2, as they are point to point runs. We suggest packing dry clothes, and your cup from your swag bag for drinks; we are a cup-free event. Day 3, we will have a place for you to put your things if you take the bus. Gotta have those dry clothes and cup!

Transportation

Each day, buses will leave from the Kodiak high school parking lot. Return buses will be at 2 hours before cutoff, and 15 minutes after cutoff.

Regardless, you won't get left behind.

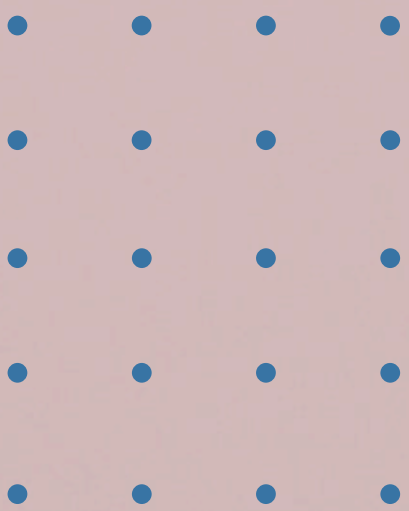
Suggested Gear

- Rain gear. It is wet in Kodiak.
- Emergency blanket.
- Bear Spray (we have limited supplies for those traveling off island).
- Snacks - No aid will be provided on trail. But we'll have aid at the start and finish. So stock up before heading out.
- A good friend - bears are less likely to bother you in groups. Make noise and be aware.
- A mobile device with the GPX files downloaded. It can be foggy and disorienting on peaks.



Please Don't

- Litter. This includes everything. If you didn't find it on the trail, it probably shouldn't be left on the trail.
- Be a jerk.
- Blame anybody for being lost. We are responsible to get you accurate information and flagging. You are responsible to follow it and have GPX files downloaded.
- Expect to park at trailheads for Heitman and Sheratin. There is very limited parking.
- Expect a cup at the end. We are a cup-free event.
